

UMCOR/First UMC: Collecting Hygiene Kits

The United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) is working in coordination with annual conferences, ERTs, disaster response coordinators, and volunteers to provide support and relief to those impacted by recent hurricanes.

To help provide immediate relief to the victims, First UMC is collecting kit materials/donations for a non-perishable Hygiene Kit. \$12 covers the cost of one complete kit. Kits will be assembled by volunteer groups - the Youth Group will assemble tonight, and Messy Church in the near future. List of kit contents includes:

- 1 Hand towel (15 \times 25 inches to 17 \times 27 inches / Kitchen, cleaning, and microfiber towels not acceptable)
- 1 Washcloth
- 1 Toothbrush (Adult size only / Do not remove from original packaging)
- 6 Adhesive bandages (¾ inch to 1 inch-size / Common household Band-Aids)
- 1 Bath-size soap (3 oz. and larger sizes only / No Ivory or Jergens soap due to moisture content)
- 1 Comb (Comb needs to be sturdy and longer than 6 inches long / No pocket combs or picks)
- 1 Metal nail file or nail clippers (No emery boards, please)
- 1 plastic bag (One-gallon size sealable bag only)
- \$1.00 to purchase toothpaste

Drop off supplies in the box located in the Narthex, or bring to the church office.
