

## THE RITUAL OF TENEBRAE

*This ancient office of darkness symbolizes the desertion of Jesus by his disciples and followers. The twelve candles represent the twelve disciples. The center candle is the Paschal candle. As the Passion narrative from the Gospel of Mark is read, candles will be extinguished one by one. At the conclusion, the Paschal candle will be carried from the sanctuary and a handbell will toll 33 times in remembrance of Christ's life on earth.*

*The candle will return on Easter morning, a sign of Christ's resurrection and eternal presence. Therefore, as the lights come up, you may depart. There is no spoken benediction . . .*
