STEWARDSHIP 2025

Our theme this year for our Stewardship Campaign is "Building Our Home: A Celebration of Belonging." Last Sunday, we listened to new First UMC member **Brian Wong** give a Stewardship Moment during worship. Here are some of his thoughts:

"What I love about this community is that there are so many ways to give. It's really a Community of Faith and Action and every week we see opportunities to



give and to love others just as Jesus loved us, and so I'm thankful to be part of this community where we truly see Faith and Action. Now I'd be remiss to speak about giving without mentioning my grandfather who taught me how to give. He was a devout Christian and he gave to the church but that's not what I remember. I remember him giving thanks constantly in good times and in bad. What he frequently said is, "Thank you God for these opportunities to love others just as Jesus loved us, and thank you God that as Christians we're all so much better at receiving (everlasting life) than giving."

And as **Pastor Greg** said: "There is power in giving generously to others in need. There is the practical level where the material gifts we give – money, food, clothing – help another person or family that is struggling. But here is a deeper level as well: our relationship with God is transformed when we give generously, without consideration for recognition or glory. God has given us the gift of grace, without calculation for who deserves it and how much, and it is that grace offered to us through Jesus Christ that redeems us. When we give in the same way, our faith in God is deepened, for we have now put that principle of grace into action. The free gift given to us is now given to others, and that is a power that every person in this world possesses, regardless of their income or wealth."

Thank you Brian and Pastor Greg for your thoughts. Our support builds our church home where all belong, making the ministries we offer a reality.
