




Children, Youth & Family Collaborative

Today during Moment for Mission, we highlight Children, Youth and Family Collaborative. CYFC is a nationally recognized organization serving over 2,500 foster youth and youth on probation, with programming in nine school districts with successful replication of its nationally recognized model in over 89 schools. CYFC Director Lydia Templeton is an FUMC Covenant Missionary.

CYFC utilizes a holistic approach to improve the educational outcomes of foster youth and youth on probation. They are "creating a culture where foster youth will no longer be synonymous with academic deficiencies and poor high school graduation rates."

CYFC makes the connection between disadvantaged youth and a caring community through partnerships with the California Department of Education, Los Angeles colleges and universities, Department of Probation, Department of Children and Family Services, Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors, community groups, and faith-based organizations.



91% of the foster vouth in the 90 schools where CYFC is on campus graduated from high school, versus 58% of foster youth in schools without CYFC.


