# Speaking Across Differences: Navigating Dialogue in Polarized Times

Throughout the summer we invite you to watch this three part minicourse from the Institute for Islamic, Christian, Jewish Studies (ICJS) in Baltimore, MD, featuring Jewish Scholar Ben Sax, Ph.D. This course will interrogate the question of what it means to dialogue within our current sociopolitical climate. Very often we teach that tolerance is a virtue in dialogue, yet should we also be tolerant of intolerance? How does that work? This course will consider a variety of views and try to chart a new dialogical path together by examining how different philosophers, political theorists, historians, and theologians have broached these questions during their own times of political peril.

First UMC will provide the links to prerecorded class sessions and resources that you can watch when it is convenient for you. Then, via Zoom on the following dates, Rev. Keri will facilitate a dialogue with those who have viewed the content.
